Rehearsal dates are good even if a date falls on a scheduled school closing.

*Rehearsals run from 7:00 PM – 9:00PM except Sunday rehearsals which run from 2:00PM – 4:00PM.

*We ask all players to refrain from wearing fragrances during rehearsals and concerts.

*Early school closing due to inclement weather cancels rehearsal for that night.

If school is canceled in the morning due to inclement weather **but** road conditions improve during the day **and** parking lots and walkways at JCHS are cleared, we **may** have rehearsal that night. **Check your email for notifications.**

Obviously, in all cases of inclement weather, personal discretion and safety comes first.

*All concerts are held at Mitchell Auditorium in the Richardson Fine Arts building on the Lincoln campus at the corner of Dunklin and Lafayette Streets. Enter in the door to the right of the tall garage door.

*Attire for all concerts is formal black.

Men: black suit or tux with white dress shirt and black bow tie.

Women: Conservative black dresses (long or knees covered when seated) or black slacks and top. Closed-toe shoes are preferred over sandals.

Exceptions for concert dress are the Spooktacular concerts when costumes are strongly suggested!
